Medicines In School

In order to comply with recent Government Guidelines we need to inform you that we are only allowed to give your child medicines that have been prescribed by a doctor.

We can no longer accept parental consent to administer, painkillers such as Calpol to a child.

We are only allowed to give a dose of penicillin/ antibiotics if this is one of four, therefore if the dose is lower than four the medicine is to be

given by the parent at suitable times; before school, after school and bedtime.

Any requests for medication to be administered should come via the school office so that the necessary paperwork can be completed.
